Vast repositories of human knowledge are now freely available online to all California K-12 students, public schools and county offices of education! The California State Library has partnered with the California Department of Education to make these massive collections available through the **K-12 Online Content Project**.

These content resources, **Encyclopedia Britannica**, **ProQuest**, **TeachingBooks.net** are commonly referred to as "library databases". They will provide CA teachers, school librarians and students with a broad spectrum of digital information (content): books, scientific research, newspaper articles, photos, videos and more – all aligned with the curriculum that California has created for its schools.
